

Key Stage 4 Curriculum 2024/25

The Key Stage 4 Curriculum at Trinity Academy Leeds is broad and balanced with a strong core in English, mathematics and science. We support students' personal development by meeting the DFE requirements of Religious, Ethics and Citizenship (REC). Student experiences are extended by a wide selection of option subjects students can choose from.

Destination 2026 is launched with all students during our options evening. Students and parents are guided by expert staff and the options booklet, to make informed decisions about which option subjects they wish to choose. Most students will study the full set of Ebacc subjects of English, Maths, Science, Spanish and a Humanities subject. The first choice for students to select is between History or Geography. Students are then given free choice across a range of additional option subjects. The subjects that make up our curriculum have been carefully selected to ensure students are fully prepared for any future study or career path. At Trinity Academy Leeds we believe in making sure students complete the right qualifications that lead to success.
