

Week 1: Modification

modification:	changing the quality of nouns or verbs using additional information, usually adjectives and adverbs.
adverb:	a word which modifies, or describes, a verb.

Week 2: Expansion

expansion:	adding phrases or clauses to sentences to make them more complex. <i>Dracula, <u>the terrifying vampire</u>, approached me. (phrase)</i> <i>Dracula was a terrifying vampire, <u>who approached me in a sinister manner</u>. (clause)</i>
phrase:	a small group of words that does not contain a verb. e.g. <i>the terrifying vampire.</i>
motif:	a repeated structure, contrast or literary device linked to the key themes.

Week 3: Context

World War I	a war fought from 1914 to 1918 between the Allies, notably Britain, France, Russia, and Italy, and the Central Powers: Germany, Austria-Hungary, Bulgaria, and the Ottoman Empire.
trench warfare:	the form of fighting in which opposing sides attack, counterattack, and defend from systems of trenches dug into the ground.

stage directions:	an instruction in the text of a play indicating the movement, position, or tone of an actor, or the sound effects and lighting.
colon:	used to give emphasis, present dialogue, introduce lists or text.
dialogue:	a conversation between two or more people.
monologue:	a long speech spoken by one actor in a play.

agency:	the ability to take action or choose what action to take.
juxtaposition:	two things being placed close together with contrasting effect.
symbolism:	the use of people or things to represent powerful ideas or qualities.

non-Standard English:	is the informal version of the language, which can change depending on where it is being spoken.
dialect:	is a form of a language spoken by a group of people.
colloquialism	a word or phrase which is not formal.
